





Training Course **Leaders without Borders**



About the Project

This project promotes leadership as a vital skill that can be learned and mastered over time and provides the youth with some leadership skills/tools that they can apply within their everyday life and within teams at their organizations, communities and throughout their professional career.



Objectives of the training

We will address leadership aspects on three levels:

- ❑ Highlight leadership competencies and attitude
- ❑ Break those into a set of knowledge and skills
- ❑ Practice these skills so it will eventually be part of the behavior

We will help the youngsters to manifest leadership actions through their behavior and transform their thinking to CONSCIOUSLY wear the hat of a leader and lead the way for the group.

Create a group of future youth leaders from different cultural backgrounds and youth fields, who will eventually keep in touch with each other to create bigger initiatives/movements in the future.




Target Group

Hosting Organization


Oslo Kajakklubb (OKK) in Norway is a relatively large sports club offering kayaking to about 2300 members. We have a large training center for indoor and outdoor activities located in the Oslo fjord since it was created in 1931.

We provide sports, training and water related activity to children, youth, grownups and elderly people, including disabled people and other groups with needing help to get started with kayaking and outdoor activities.

We offer:

- training and guided tours in kayak
- summer camps for close to 180 children
- summer jobs for approx. 30 young people
- free training and outdoor activities for refugees and people originating from other cultures and countries.

One of our main goals as a club is to offer activities for all people regardless of age, cultural background, economic situation, etc. based on inclusion and diversity. We collaborate with various organizations and the local municipal administrations in Oslo.




Reimbursement
